Landlord and Tenant Rights

Programs include information workshops and presentations on landlord-tenant issues; landlord applications for rent adjustments applications for no-fault evictions and payment of relocation assistance; investigation of complaints from tenants concerning RSO violations; information and referrals to other agencies for housing issues outside HCIDLA's purview.
